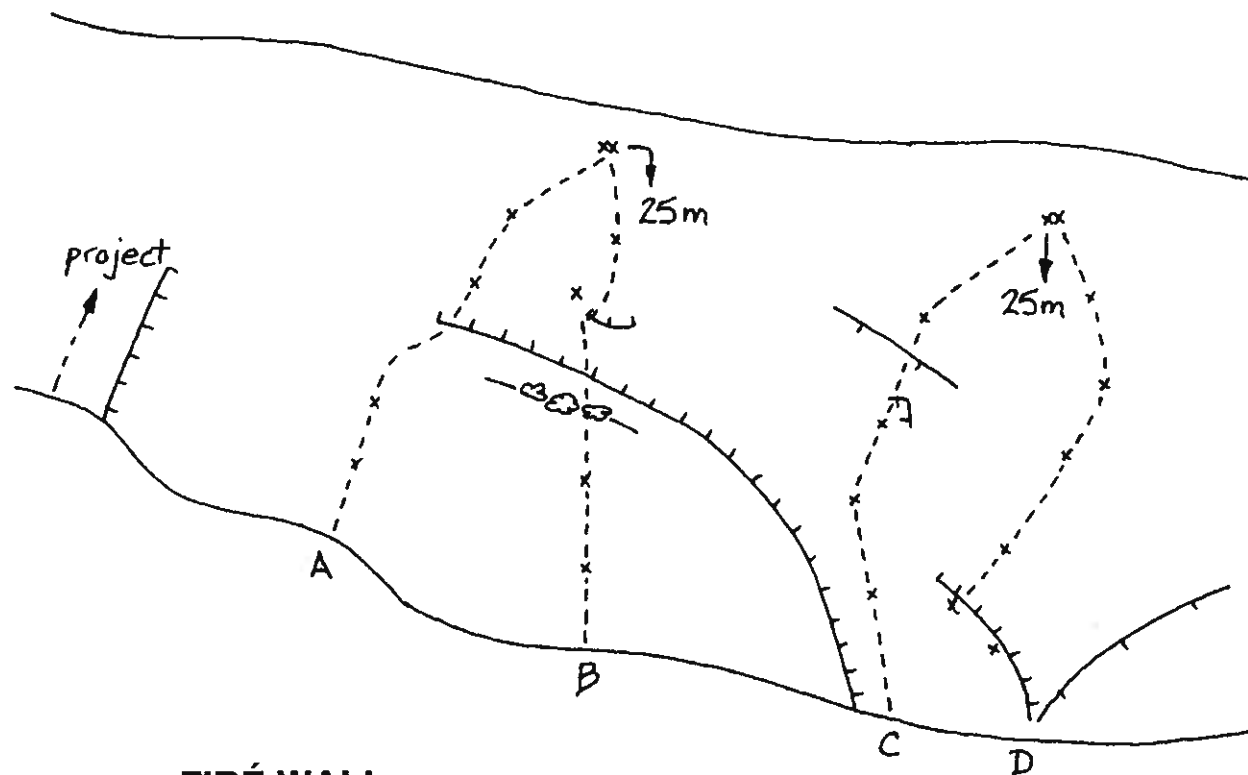


BATHTUB BROOK

This relatively undeveloped area is located in the drainage north of Harvie Heights (three drainages northwest of The Stoneworks). The climbs are on two cliffs: French Made Crag, a steep wall on the left (northwest) side of the creek; and Firé Wall, a steep slab across the creek from French Made Crag. All routes are fully equipped. The routes on Fire Wall have received very few ascents and so no quality ratings are given.

Approach

From the Harvie Heights access road, follow Rundle Road to its end and park at a locked gate. Continue up a gravel road (private land) to a quarry. Bypass the quarry on the right and continue up past a waterfall to gain the creek bed above. Follow the creek bed past some enjoyable slickrock scrambling, eventually reaching the cliffs in about 45 minutes from Harvie Heights. The approach is tricky except in dry weather when the creek is low.
